More specifically, Chris and his colleagues have piloted a geospatial, equity-informed, environmental health screening tool that measures environmental exposures, environmental effects, socioeconomic conditions and sensitive populations. The tool also quantifies cumulative environmental, community and health effects in an effort to better support better land-use decision-making.
