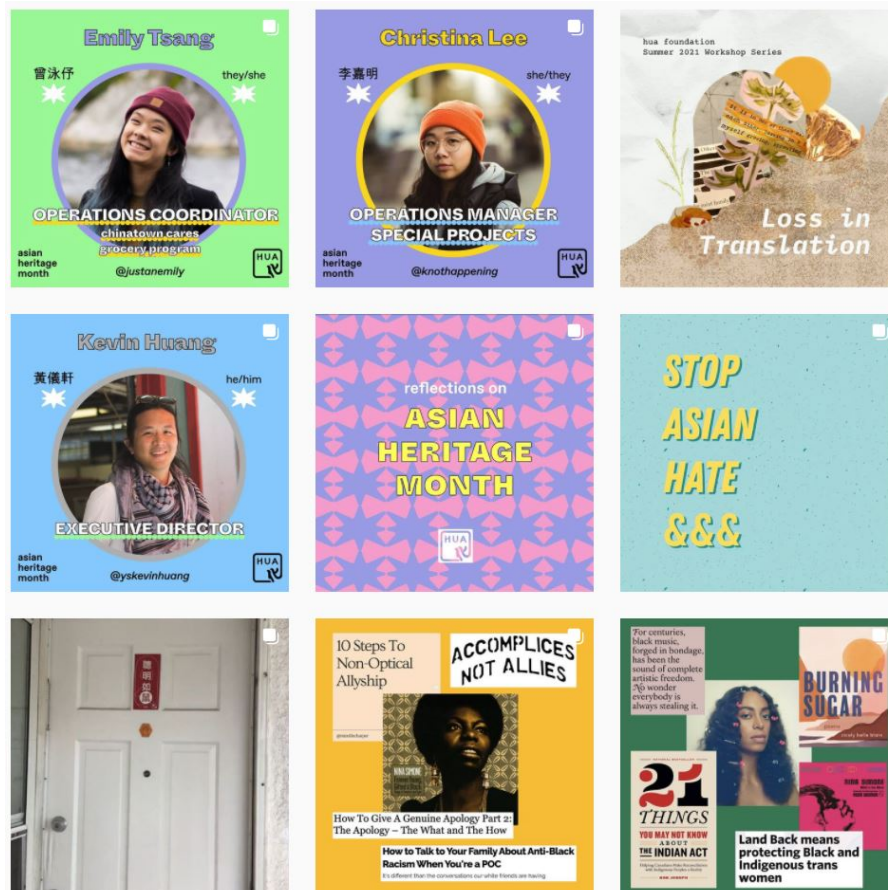
Learning hubs will have an opportunity to present and conduct virtual workshops at BCCI 3 for a more collaborative effort in our ongoing Community of Practice.
